

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The Winery Purchase Process

If you are considering the sale of your winery or vineyard it is critically important that you have a thorough understanding of the entire process. Initially, it would be best to contact us via phone or email to discuss the options available.

Generally, there are 3 ways to attract buyers to your property. For businesses concerned with employees and customers being frightened off by a potential sale, we offer totally discreet marketing. Using this approach means that our advertising of your property will be absolutely general in the presentation. Your company name will not be used, your specific location will not be named, and no photos of your property will be used. We will mention total vineyard acreage, production capacity in cases of wine, and sale price. Nothing will be stated that anyone could discern that your winery is for sale.

The next level of marketing is what we call semidiscreet. Using this approach, we will still not name your winery/vineyard but will use actual photos and will give a more specific location, usually just the County name. We will give more details about acreage, production, equipment etc.

The most complete approach is where the property is named including the specific location. In addition, we will provide more complete details on all aspects of the property including more photos and comprehensive information. This marketing approach brings the most results and usually brings more qualified buyers.

Working closely together with you, we will adapt the best aspects of all three techniques to establish the best possible way to market your property in conjunction with your own needs and desires.









Seven Oaks





Seven Oaks Farm was placed on the National Register of Historic Places and is now considered a Virginia historic landmark. It is located in Greenwood, Virginia just outside of Charlottesville. Spanning 100 acres, this beautiful property is home to 15 acres of vineyards, four tenant houses, several barns, a gym, stables and a greenhouse. The estate itself stands as 6,870 sq. ft. of finished Greek revival architecture. Beneath the outstanding view of the Blue Ridge Mountains, you will find seven varieties of grapes in the now mature vineyard.

Seven Oaks has been renamed "Septenary Vineyards." It operates as a high-quality winery specializing in dramatically elegant weddings and events in a superbly beautiful, historically significant setting. From the time Lewis and Clark set out west from Seven Oaks after having their last beer in Virginia for several years until the present, Seven Oaks has been a great place to leave from while departing on wondrous adventures or a fantastic destination to spend a relaxing afternoon.

Seven Oaks sold in the spring of 2014. The new owners plan to create one of Virginia's most elegant wineries, and have renamed the property Septenary Winery.

La Grange



The Winery at La Grange is located in Haymarket, Virginia at the base of Bull Run Mountain just 40 miles south-west of Washington D.C. The farm consists of 22 acres, 8 of which are vines. 

Surrounded by peach and apple orchards, Naked Valley is absolutely the perfect destination for families in addition to wine lovers.






